Shop Clitheroe

The Shop Clitheroe loyalty card was created to enhance shoppers experience within Clitheroe.

Every time customers spend over £5 in one of Clitheroe's participating businesses they receive a loyalty stamp. Once they've collected ten stamps they're entered into a free prize draw to win £50 worth of gift vouchers.

Draws take place every month and on top of this, their card entitles them to special offers and discounts that businesses may offer throughout the year.

Winning gift vouchers are redeemable in any participating Shop Clitheroe business and when a customer redeems a gift voucher the business owner simply contacts the Shop Clitheroe administration who will organise a re-imbusement so they're never out of pocket!
